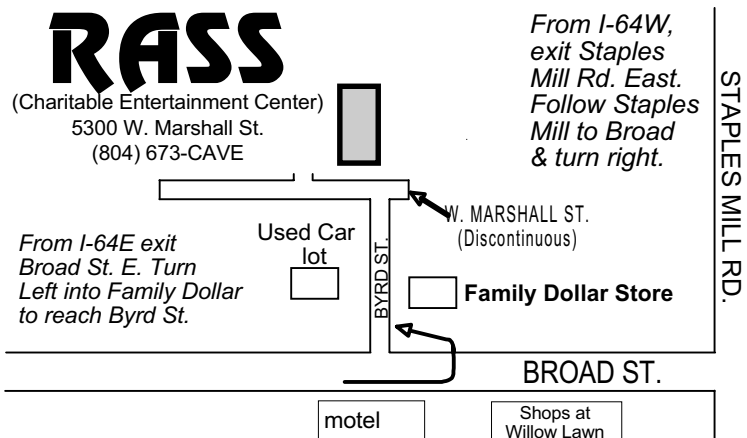

Caving and Christmas Money Mixed
